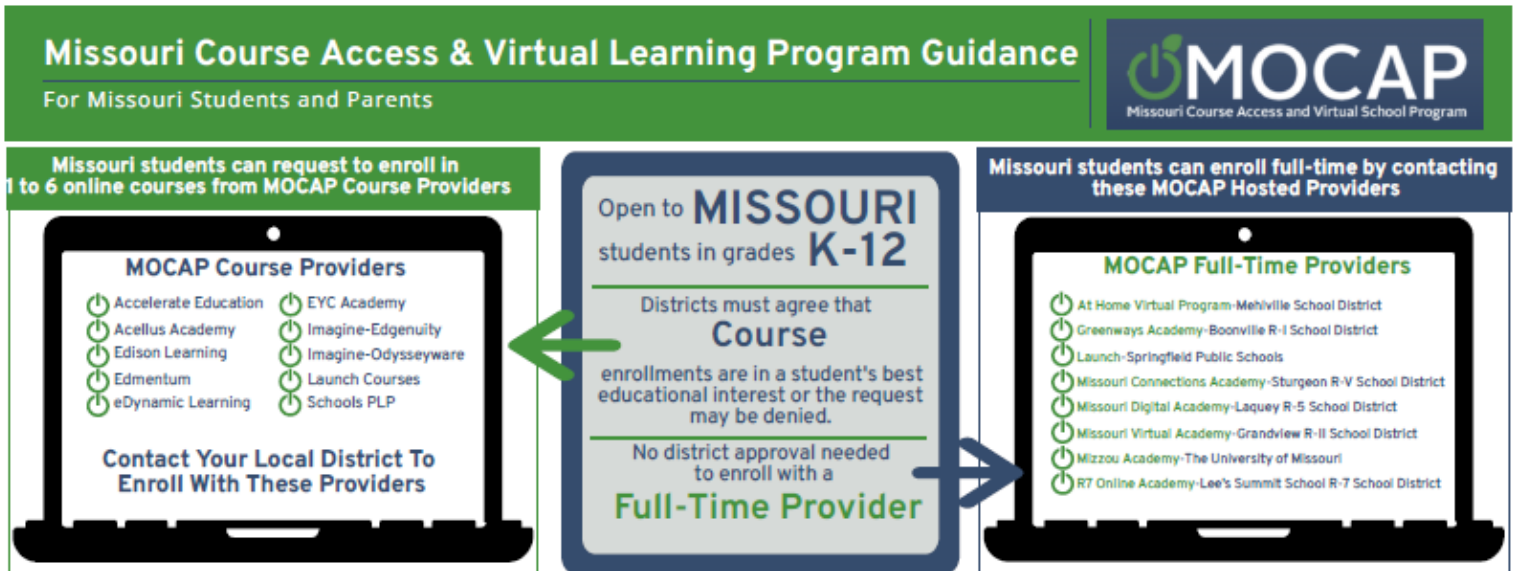








MOCAP Online Learning Options Are:

- Available to all Missouri students in grades K-12
- Provide courses taught by Missouri certified teachers
- Aligned to Missouri Learning Standard
- Allow students access to courses that may not be offered locally



An Overview of MOCAP

-  Districts are not required to provide technology for MOCAP students.
-  Full-time students are transferred to the MOCAP provider's host district, which has an impact on MSHSAA eligibility.
-  MOCAP courses are aligned to Missouri Learning Standards and are taught by Missouri certified teachers.
-  Students who do not participate in full-time MOCAP coursework will be transferred back to their resident district.
-  MOCAP students are required to take Missouri state assessments.
-  MOCAP allows students to take rigorous and unique courses aligned to their interests.

Ways to Enroll in MOCAP




Enroll in a Full-Time MOCAP Program




Contact Provider

- Use the provider contact information provided on the MOCAP website at mocap.mo.gov to reach out to the provider you where you want to enroll your student.
- Make arrangements to enroll with the provider and provider's host district.




Complete Enrollment

- Complete the host district's and provider's enrollment process, including verification of Missouri residency.
- Your student will transfer from their current district of residence and become a student in the host district.




Select Classes

- The provider's staff will assist you and your student in selecting courses aligned to your student's interests and educational and grade-level requirements.




Participate in Classes

- Your student will participate regularly in all enrolled courses.
- Teachers and support staff from the MOCAP provider are available for assistance if your student encounters difficulties.
- Your student is required to participate in MAP and EOC tests.




Enroll in MOCAP Courses




Contact Your School

- Notify your school that your student would like to enroll in one or more MOCAP courses.
- Your school will make a decision to approve or deny your enrollment request.




Provider Contact

- Your school district will contact the MOCAP course provider and begin the process of enrolling your student in the MOCAP course or courses.




Select Classes

- The provider's staff and your school staff will assist in selecting courses aligned to your student's interests and educational and grade-level requirements.



Participate in Classes

- Your student will participate regularly in all enrolled courses.
- Teachers and support staff from the MOCAP provider are available for assistance if your student encounters difficulties.
- Your student will participate in MAP and EOC tests in your school district.



Monitor Progress

- Your student's progress in courses will be monitored by your school and will be shared with you.
