PARENTS

MoVIP is a Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education program offering online courses. MoVIP offers 172 classes in grades K-12, and students can be either part-time or full-time. For a complete list of courses and a course catalog, visit www.movip.org, and click on "Course Information."

Students Served

All Missouri residents (public, private and/or home-schooled students) can enroll. MoVIP expands the range of courses and opportunities offered to Missouri students. We offer classes in seven different foreign language as well as 19 advanced placement classes. MoVIP provides education to students who are homebound for medical reasons. High-achieving students can take accelerated courses. Students who need extra time or additional support can also utilize MoVIP.

Credit Earned

MoVIP is not considered a school district; it is a program offering courses for students to earn credit. Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education regulations require that Missouri public school districts accept MoVIP credit. Upon completion of a MoVIP course, students receive a percentage grade. A transcript with the course and grade is then available. Diplomas are granted by the local school district.

Funding

Because of recent state financial restraints, MoVIP is now a tuition program. School districts or parents pay for MoVIP classes. Prices are by semester class and vary according to online vendor charges. If you have a medically fragile student, please contact the MoVIP office at 573-751-2453 for additional information.

Classes

MoVIP students are guided by Missouri-certificated teachers in courses delivered over the Internet. MoVIP has various start dates to accommodate the schedules of schools and families. When registering for classes, select the start date you prefer. The average course will take 18-20 weeks to complete. Students can move through classes at a faster pace or they can have additional time to complete a course, if necessary. Parents are encouraged to work with local school officials to select classes to meet graduation requirements.
